


## Going Live Today!

Multiple suggestions have been provided to improve the usability of CRIS as it relates to reviewing medication orders and medication administration tasks. We have compiled these suggestions and have created a new tab named the Meds View tab. The Meds View tab provides users with the ability to filter the Read-only view to medications orders and medication administration information. The tab contains features and functions that can be set as customized views in order to view medication history. A tutorial was created and located within the tab for easy access.
